No. F. 14(25)/58-Dev/64/AHD—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Indian Fisheries Act, 1897, the Chief Commissioner of Delhi is pleased to make the following rules for the protection of fish in the waters of the Union Territory of Delhi, the same having been previously published with his Notification NO. F. 14(25)/58-Dev/64/AHD. dated 6th March, 1964:-

RULES

- 1. All fishing is prohibited for a period of two years in the waters specified below:-
 - (i) Government Fish Farm, Opposite Seelampur village.
 - (ii) Shamshi Talab at Mehrauli.
 - (iii) Portion of Yamuna river between Spur No. 2 & 3 upstream Okhla Headworks.
 - (iv) Portion of Yamuna river 40 yards below Spur No.11 downstream Okhla Headworks.
- 2. Any beach of the foregoing rules shall be punishable with a fine which may extend to one hundred rupees and when the breach is a continuing breach with a further fine which may extend to 10 rupees for every day after the date of the first conviction during which the breach is proved to have been persisted in.
- 3. Any fixed engine or net or other implement for fishing used in contravention of rule 1 may be seized by any Fisheries Officer or any person specially empowered (by name or by virtue of his office) by the Chief Commissioner, Delhi in this behalf.
- 4. Any fixed engine erected or net or other implement for fishing used in contravention of rule 1 shall be liable by order of any Magistrate to forfeiture. Any fish taken by means of any such fixed engine or net or other implement shall be liable to forfeiture at the spot.
