NOTICE INVITING TENDERS

- 1. Director of Animal Husbandry, Government of NCT of Delhi invites tender rates for **Allopathic Veterinary Medicines, Ayurvedic/Herbal Veterinary Medicines, as mentioned in the enclosed lists at Annexure I,** for the supply of quantities, at the given periodicity and location for a period of two year from the date of issue of rate contract.
- 2. This is an E-tender in two bid system (Technical & Financial separately) and tender can be downloaded from and filed online at https://govtprocurement.delhi.gov.in by those tenderers who have a valid registration with the application service provider of NIC, Delhi State Centre, 6th Floor, C-Wing, Vikas Bhavan-II, (Near Metcalfe House), Civil Lines, Delhi-110054. Duly completed technical bid/financial bid along with requisite documents are required to be submitted online as per the schedule given below:

- 3. The tender shall be opened by the tender committee/Technical Committee duly constituted by the competent authority as per the schedule given above. The bids will be opened in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives who choose to be present on the occasion. In case no tenderer or their authorized representative is present the bids will be opened as per the schedule. The technical committee will evaluate the tender document submitted by bidders at Directorate of Animal Husbandry on next day of opening of Tender Bids.
- 4. The financial bid of the concerned tenderer shall only be opened if tenderer qualifies the conditions of the Technical Bid.
- 5. In case the date on which tender is to be opened is declared as holiday by the Govt. the tender will be opened on next working day at the same time.

6. The composition of the medicine, packing size etc. should not vary from the specifications mentioned in the tender document failing which it shall stand rejected automatically.

7. **Bidders Eligibility:**

Firms intending to participate in the tender should first ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility criteria as prescribed in the tender. The main conditions of the tender are:

- (a) Only licensed Indian drug manufacturers/authorized dealers are eligible to participate in the tender. In case of imported medicine, the tenderer should have valid registration for import of drugs & import license.
- (b) Pre-qualification/ post qualification of the manufacturers/authorized dealers of Allopathic **Veterinary Medicine** and **Ayurvedic/Herbal Veterinary Medicine** shall be based upon the financial standing to latest **I.T.C.C. Annual report (Balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account)** of last 03 years
- (c) In case the firm is involved in manufacturing of human as well as veterinary medicines and it is not possible to provide a separate balance sheet for Veterinary Medicines, an affidavit duly signed by Tenderer/Proprietor/Partner/Director/ Karta and attested by a Notary Public along with CA certificate should be submitted as per Annexure— III & IV.
- (d) The manufacturers/authorized dealers of medicines should have currently valid **Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) certificate** as per the requirement of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act and rules of Government of India from Competent Authority. Copy of the certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the concerned country, in case of imported medicines/vaccines is to be furnished by the tenderer. The State Govt. reserve the right to have the premises of the manufacturers/authorized dealers inspected for ensuring that "GMP" (GOOD MANUFACTURING PRACTICES) as per revised schedule 'M'. The tenderer has to submit & upload Non-conviction certificate(s) issued by the concerned Drug licensing authority. The certificate should be latest one i.e. issued during past twelve months prior to the date of opening of tender along with certificate that the quoted products has not been declared as not of standard quality/spurious/adulterated for past three years.
- (e) The manufacturers/authorized dealers of medicines should have approved and permitted by the competent authority.
- (f) **Work Experience:** The Bidders should have experience on past performance on similar contracts for last 02 years and capabilities with respect to personnel, equipment and manufacturing facilities. Micro, Small and Medium enterprises (MSME) and the firms registered with concerned Ministries or Department are exempted from prior experience.
- (g) The manufacturing firm of the medicines whose rates have been quoted should be manufacturing them at least for 3 year for each medicine quoted. An affidavit stating so, signed by the Tenderer/Proprietor/Partner/Director/Karta and attested by a Notary Public should be submitted as per Annexure –III.
- (h) After award of tender it shall be the responsibility of the supplier to give uninterrupted supply of medicine/vaccine/stores, pay for any damage arising because of delay in supply, non-supply, short supply or supply of poor quality of medicines / vaccines/stores.
- (i) All supply of Veterinary Medicine should be accompanied with the batch wise authentic test reports from Govt. recognized labs. However, the Department has right to send the sample/s from consignment received for testing to the Govt. recognized laboratory. If the product is found not of standard quality, the total cost of the test will be recovered from the supplier and the supplier will have to replace the entire consignment irrespective of the

fact that the stores supplied may have been consumed. The tenderer will be liable for relevant action under the existing laws and the entire stock in such batch has to be taken back by the Tenderer within a period of 30 days of the receipt of the letter from Tender Inviting Authority. Such stock shall be taken back at the expense of the Tenderer. The Tender Inviting Authority has the right to destroy such "NOT OF STANDARD QUALITY" stock if the Tenderer does not take back the goods within the stipulated time. Tender Inviting Authority will arrange to destroy the "NOT OF STANDARD QUALITY ITEMS" within 90 days after the expiry of 30 days mentioned above without further notice, and shall also collect demurrage charges calculated at the rate of 2% per week on the value of the drugs rejected till such destruction.

or

- (j) The supplier will have to refund full payment of entire consignment against the particular invoice irrespective of the fact that part of the supplied stores may have been consumed. No further orders will be placed to supplier for that particular drug/store, as the case will be decided by the Director (AH).
- (k) All rejected store shall in any event remain and will always be at the risk of the supplier
- (I) If the product found to be of standard quality even then it will be the responsibility of the supplier to replace the quantity of medicines sent to laboratory for test of quality and to pay the testing charges to the Govt. recognized laboratory through the Director (Animal Husbandry).
- (m) If the product is found to be of sub-standard quality the supplier will have to supply a fresh complete medicines as per the supply order in place of the sub-standard medicines irrespective of the fact that the stores supplied may have been consumed or not. All rejected store shall in any event remain and will always be at the risk of the supplier.
- (n) The manufacturing/marketing firm should submit an affidavit duly signed by its Owner/Partner/Authorized Signatory and to be attested by a Notary Public that the firm is presently not blacklisted by any Government Department (Annexure-III).
- (o) Micro and small enterprises, firms registered with concerned ministry/ department are exempted from Bid Security. There is no need to submit Bid security document. The bidders only need to submit bid security declaration as per (Annexure-V).
- 8. **Registration of Suppliers:** The firms should be registered on the Public e –Procurement portal. The firms that are registered for supply of orders valued above Rupees Five Lakh should invariably be manufacturers/authorized dealers.
- 9. All the successful bidders awarded the contract has to furnish **Performance Security** equal to 3% of value of the contract for all existing contracts. The performance security may be increased or decreased as per Government orders issued from time to time. The Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Bankers Cheque or Bank Guarantee from any of commercial banks in an acceptable form drawn in favour of Director, Animal Husbandry, Govt. of Delhi payable at New Delhi shall only be accepted. If any information furnished by the tenderer is found to be incorrect or false at any time, and if at any stage the tenderer deviate from the terms and conditions of the contract agreement or his performance is found to be unsatisfactory, the contract agreement shall be liable to be terminated without any notice and the Performance Security shall be forfeited.
- 10. TDS (tax deducted at source) would be deducted from the amount payable to the contractor as per the rules/instructions /orders of Government of India.

- 11. Technical and Financial bids should be filed/uploaded separately. Since it is an e-tendering, **there is no need to file the bid manually**. The bidders are advised to authenticate and scan (Clearly visible) all the documents specified in the technical bid and upload the same on the notified website.
- 12. The rate contract will be governed by the **terms & conditions** laid down in the tender document enclosed.
- a) In the Schedule of Requirement, no quantity is mentioned; only the anticipated drawl is mentioned without any commitment in the rate contract.
- b) The purchaser reserves the right to conclude one or more than one rate contract for the same item.
- c) The firm as well as the purchaser are entitled to withdraw/cancel the Rate Contract by serving an appropriate notice to each other giving 15 (fifteen) days time. However, once a supply order is placed on the supplier for supply of a definite quantity in terms of the rate contract during the validity period of the rate contract, that supply order becomes a valid and binding contract.
- d) The purchaser has the option to renegotiate the price with the rate contract holders.
- e) In case of emergency, the purchaser may purchase the same item through *ad hoc* contract with a new supplier.
- f) The terms of delivery in rate contracts are free delivery at consignee's site as per purchaser directions.
- g) Online supply orders, incorporating definite quantity of goods to be supplied along with all other required conditions following the rate contract terms, are to be issued for obtaining supplies through the rate contract
- h) The purchaser and the authorized users of the rate contract are entitled to place online supply orders up to the last day of the validity of the rate contract and, though supplies against such supply orders will be effected beyond the validity period of the rate contract, all such supplies will be guided by the terms and conditions of the rate contract.
- i) The Rate contract of tenders medicines from the supplier, the prices to be paid for such goods shall not exceed those stipulated in the rate contract and the other salient terms and conditions of the purchase should be in line with those specified in the rate contract.
- j) The period of rate contract will be for two years.
- k) Micro and small enterprises and the firms registered with concerned Ministries or Department are Exempted from submissions of Bid Security. There is no need to submit Bid security document. The bidders only need to submit bid security declaration as per (Annexure-V).
 - I) Rate contract will be guided by "Fall Clause".

Fall Clause: If at any time during the execution of the rate contract, contract holder reduces its price or sells or even offers to sell the rate contracted goods following conditions of sale similar to those of the rate contract, at a price lower than the rate contract price, to any person or organization during the currency of the rate contract, the rate contract price will be automatically reduced with effect from that date for all the subsequent supplies under the rate contract and the rate contract amended accordingly. Other parallel rate contract holders, if any, will also to be given opportunity to reduce their price as well, by notifying the reduced price to them and giving them 07 (Seven) days time to intimate their revised prices, if they so desire, in sealed cover to be opened in public on the specified date and time and further action will be taken as per standard practice.

- m) Performance Security: Depending on the anticipated overall drawal against a rate contract and, also, anticipated number of parallel rate contracts to be issued for an item. Supplier have to deposit Performance Security @ 3% (Three percent) of the value of supply order in the supply orders issued against rate contracts on the rate contract holder. The performance security may be increased or decreased as per Government orders issued time to time.
- n) Renewal of rate Contracts: The new rate contracts are made operative right after the expiry of the existing rate contracts without any gap for all rate contracted items. In case, however, it is not possible to conclude new rate contracts due to some special reasons, timely steps will be taken to extend the existing rate contracts with same terms, conditions etc. for a suitable period, with the consent of the rate contract holders. Rate contracts of the firms, who do not agree to such extension, will be left out. Also, while extending the existing rate contracts, it will be ensured that the price trend is not lower.

o) Handling Procurement in urgencies/Emergencies and Disaster Management:

To speed-up the procurement in urgencies/Emergencies and Disaster Management procurement may be increased or decreased with sanction of Development Commissioner. Use of following modes of procurements may be considered to handle above mentioned situations:

- ii) Direct Procurement by Purchase Committee
- iii) SLTE/Limited/Single Tender Enquiry,
- 13. The financial bids of the concerned tenderer shall only be opened if he qualifies the conditions of the Technical Bid. The financial bids will be opened online as per the schedule date and time given in the NIT, in the presence of tenderers or their authorized representatives, who wish to be present on the occasion. In case no tenderer or their authorized representative is present the bids will be opened as per the schedule.
- 14. Each and every page /paper of the tender documents uploaded should be serially numbered, duly signed and stamped by the tenderers and duly authenticated. The originals of all documents should be carefully preserved since they may be demanded after opening of tender to check the authenticity.
- 15. The payment to the tenderer will be made through Electronic Clearing System (ECS)/Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS), therefore, tenderer shall provide correct Name of Bank, Bank Address, Account holder's name, Account No, IFSC code & MICR code of the bank.

- 2. This is an E-tender in two bid system (Technical & Financial separately) and tender can be down loaded from and filed online at https://govtprocurement.delhi.gov.in by those tenderers who have a valid registration with the application service provider of NIC, Delhi State Centre, 6th Floor, C-Wing, Vikas Bhavan-II, (Near Metcalfe House), Civil Lines, Delhi-110054. Duly completed technical bid/financial bid along with requisite documents are required to be submitted online as per the scheduled given below:

The bids will be opened in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives who choose to be present on the occasion. In case no tenderer or their authorized representative is present the bids will be opened as per the schedule. The technical committee will evaluate the tender document submitted by bidders at Directorate of Animal Husbandry next day of opening of Tender Bids.
- 4. The technical bids will be evaluated by the technical evaluation committee. The financial bid of the concerned tenderer shall only be opened if he qualifies the conditions of the Technical Bid.
- 5. In case the date on which tender is to be opened is declared as holiday by the Govt. the tender will be opened on next working day at the same time.

- 6. The composition of the medicine, packing size etc. should not vary from the specifications mentioned in the tender document failing which it shall stand rejected automatically.
- 7. The rate contract will be governed by the **terms & conditions** laid down in the tender document enclosed.
 - a) In the Schedule of Requirement, no quantity is mentioned; only the anticipated drawl is mentioned without any commitment in the rate contract.
 - b) The purchaser reserves the right to conclude one or more than one rate contract for the same item.
 - c) The firm as well as the purchaser are entitled to withdraw/cancel the Rate Contract by serving an appropriate notice on each other giving 15 (fifteen) days time. However, once a supply order is placed on the supplier for supply of a definite quantity in terms of the rate contract during the validity period of the rate contract, that supply order becomes a valid and binding contract.
 - d) The purchaser has the option to renegotiate the price with the rate contract holders.
 - e) In case of emergency, the purchaser may purchase the same item through *ad hoc* contract with a new supplier.
 - f) The terms of delivery in rate contracts are free delivery at consignee's site as per purchaser directions.

 - j) The period of rate contract will be for two years.
 - k) Micro and small enterprises and the firms registered with concerned Ministries or Department or Exempted from submissions of Bid Security. There is no need to submit Bid security document The bidders only need to submit bid security declaration as per (Annexure-V).
 - I) Rate contract will be guided by "Fall Clause".

Fall Clause:

If at any time during the execution of the rate contract, contract holder reduces its price or sells or even offers to sell the rate contracted goods following conditions of sale similar to those of the rate contract, at a price lower than the rate contract price, to any person or organization during the currency of the rate contract, the rate contract price will be automatically reduced with effect from that date for all the subsequent supplies under the rate contract and the rate contract amended accordingly. Other parallel rate contract holders, if any, will also to be given opportunity to reduce their price as well, by notifying the reduced price to them and giving them 07 (Seven)

days time to intimate their revised prices, if they so desire, in sealed cover to be opened in public on the specified date and time and further action will be taken as per standard practice.

8. **Registration of Suppliers:** The firms should be registered on the Public e – Procurement portal. The firms that are registered for supply of orders valued above Rupees Five Lakh should invariably be manufacturers/authorized dealers.

9. Bidders Eligibility: -

Firms intending to participate in the tender should first ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility criteria as prescribed in the tender. The main conditions of the tender are:

- (a) Only licensed Indian drug manufacturers/authorized dealers are eligible to participate in the tender. In case of imported medicine, the tenderer should have valid registration for import of drugs & import license.
- (b) Pre-qualification/ post qualification of the manufacturers/authorized dealers of Allopathic Veterinary Medicine and Ayurvedic/Herbal Veterinary Medicine shall be based upon the financial standing to latest I.T.C.C. Annual report (Balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account) of last 03 years. Companies involved in production of both human and veterinary medicines shall provide copy of balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account in respect of Vety. Medicines only. In case the firm is involved in manufacturing of human as well as veterinary medicines and it is not possible to provide a separate balance sheet for Veterinary Medicines, an affidavit duly signed by Tenderer/Proprietor/Partner/Director/ Karta and attested by a Notary Public along with CA certificate should be submitted as per Annexure— III & IV.
- The manufacturers/authorized dealers of medicines should have currently valid Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) certificate as per the requirement of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act and rules of Government of India from Competent Authority. Copy of the certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the concerned country, in case of imported medicines/vaccines is to be furnished by the tenderer. The State Govt. reserves the right to have the premises of the manufacturers/authorized dealers inspected for ensuring that "GMP" (GOOD MANUFACTURING PRACTICES) as per revised schedule 'M'. The tenderer has to submit & upload Non-conviction certificate(s) issued by the concerned Drug licensing authority. The certificate should be latest one i.e. issued during past twelve months prior to the date of opening of tender along with certificate that quoted products has not been declared as not of standard the quality/spurious/adulterated for past three years.
- (d) The manufacturers/authorized dealers of medicines should have approved and permitted by the competent authority RI division.
- (e) Work Experience: The Bidders should have experience on past performance on similar contracts for last 02 years and capabilities with respect to personnel, equipment and manufacturing facilities. Micro, Small and Medium enterprises (MSME) and the firms registered with concerned Ministries or Department are exempted from prior experience.
- 10. The tenderers must indicate the offer price clearly for each unit. Only one rate (offer price) should be quoted against one item strictly as per specifications mentioned otherwise tender will not be considered for the said item. No second

rate with variation or options in specifications will be considered. The offer price should be **inclusive of all applicable taxes**.

- 11. The rates quoted by the bidder shall be competitive with the rates governing supplies to other parties. The rates shall never be higher than those governing supplies to the other parties/MRP but the bidder is free to offer lower rates.
- 12. In case of equal rates have been quoted by more than one tenderer for any item the supply order will be given to each tenderer in equal ratio.

13. Responsibility of the Tenderers for Executing the Contract.

Depending on the anticipated overall drawal against a rate contract and, have, anticipated number. Supplier have to deposit performance security @ 3% (three percent) of the value of supply order in the supply orders issued against rate contracts on the rate contract holder. The performance security may be increased or decreased as per government orders issued from time to time. Once the tender is finalized in favour of tenderer, he has to **furnish performance security** as directed by the Department in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Bankers Cheque or Bank Guarantee from any of commercial banks in an acceptable form payable at New Delhi drawn in favour of the Director, Animal Husbandry, Govt. of NCT of Delhi and execute the agreement within the period mentioned in the award letter. The tenderers shall perform the contract in all respect in accordance with the terms and conditions thereof. The stores and every constituent part thereof, whether in the possession or control of the tenderers, their agents or servants as the case may be shall remain in every respect at the risk and cost of the tenderers until the actual delivery of the stores is made to the department at the stipulated time.

After the tender is finalized in favour of tenderer, Department will intimate him for execution of the agreement.

14. Earnest Money Deposit (Bid Security) and Performance Security

- i) Micro and small enterprises and the firms registered with concerned Ministries or Department are Exempted from submissions of Bid Security. There is no need to submit Bid security document. The bidders only need to submit bid security declaration as per (Annexure-V) as per OM. No.F.9/4/2020-PPD dated 12/11/2020 of Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India.
- ii) The **performance Security** shall remain valid for a period of **Sixty days** beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations including warranty obligations. In case the contract period is extended further, the validity of Performance Security shall also be extended by the supplier accordingly. Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Bankers Cheque or Bank Guarantee from any of commercial banks in an acceptable form payable at New Delhi drawn in favour of the Director (AH) shall be accepted.
- iii) Government will not pay any interest on Performance Security.
- iv) If the contractor fails or neglects to observe or perform any of his obligations under the contract, it shall be lawful for Govt. of NCT of Delhi to **forfeit** the Security deposit furnished by the contractor without prejudice to any other right or remedy available against the contractor.

v) If any information furnished by the tenderer is found to be incorrect or false at any time, and if at any stage the tenderer deviate from the terms and conditions of the contract agreement or his performance is found to be unsatisfactory, the contract agreement shall be liable to be terminated and the Performance Security shall forfeited.

15. Changes in constitution of firms:

Any change in the ownership pattern of the supplier/contracting party will be immediately notified to the Government in writing; however, it will not nullify the provisions of the contract. The contract obligations shall devolve on the successor owners.

16. Test report of the consignment:

a. All supply of Veterinary Medicine should be accompanied with the batch wise authentic test reports from Govt. recognized labs. However, the Department has right to send the sample/s from consignment received for testing to the Govt. recognized laboratory. If the product is found not of **standard quality,** the total cost of the test will be recovered from the supplier and the supplier will have to replace the entire consignment irrespective of the fact that the stores supplied may have been consumed the Tenderer will be liable for relevant action under the existing laws and the entire stock in such batch has to be taken back by the Tenderer within a period of 30 days of the receipt of the letter from Tender Inviting Authority. Such stock shall be taken back at the expense of the Tenderer. The Tender Inviting Authority has the right to destroy such "NOT OF STANDARD QUALITY" stock if the Tenderer does not take back the goods within the stipulated time. Tender Inviting Authority will arrange to destroy the "NOT OF STANDARD QUALITY ITEMS" within 90 days after the expiry of 30 days mentioned above without further notice, and shall also collect demurrage charges calculated at the rate of 2% per week on the value of the drugs rejected till such destruction.

The supplier will have to refund full payment of entire consignment against the particular invoice irrespective of the fact that part of the supplied stores may have been consumed. No further orders will be placed to supplier for that particular drug/store, as the case will be decided by the Director (AH).

All rejected store shall in any event remain and will always be at the risk of the supplier.

If the product found to be of standard quality even then it will be the responsibility of the supplier to replace the quantity of medicines sent to laboratory for test of quality and to pay the testing charges to the Govt. recognized laboratory through the Director (Animal Husbandry).

- b. The consignment can also be rejected in case of visible and obvious defects. All rejected stores shall in any event remain and will always be at the risk of the supplier immediately on such rejection.
- c. The medicine/vaccine should be properly stabilized according to prescribed norms before delivery.

d. The Govt. of NCT of Delhi will inform the licensing authority and also the authority who issue the GMP certificate about the incidence of such rejection along with the detailed reason for such rejection.

17. Marking and packing:-

- The supplier shall supply the stores with proper packing and marking. The stores supplied by the supplier should strictly conform to the labeling provisions laid down under the Drugs & Cosmetics Rules, 1940.
- ii) Stores shall be marked with the words in capital and bold letters, 'FOR SUPPLY TO GOVT. OF NCT OF DELHI & NOT FOR SALE'. MRP should of course not be printed. Such packing shall clearly indicate the description, quantity and other details of medicines. Any damage due to defective packing will be recovered from the contractor.

18. Delivery:-

- (i) The time for the date of delivery of stores stipulated in the supply order shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and delivery must be completed not later than the date/s as specified in the order and period shall be counted from the actual date of delivery by speed post of Postal Department, Govt. of India or the acknowledgement of the supply order received by hand. If the last date of delivery of goods happens to be a holiday or declared as a holiday, the next working day shall be the last day of delivery of goods.
- (ii) Place of Delivery of Goods: for I/C Central Medicine Store, Veterinary Hospital Complex, Palam-New Delhi-110045 or District HQ or any other Vety. Hospital, if required (it will be indicated in supply orders).
- (iii) The discretion to accept the delivery of goods after the expiry of delivery period shall completely lie with the Director (AH).
- (iv) Extension of delivery period: tenderer can seek extension of delivery period explaining the reason for delay. The extension of delivery may be granted by the Director (AH), if demand still exists.
- (v) The delivery of goods can be accepted if demand still exists after expiry period, a penalty of 2% of the value of the order for every delayed week or part of week subject to maximum of 10% will be imposed. Goods will be normally not be accepted beyond 5 weeks of the last date of delivery period.
- (vi) In case any of drugs being rejected or not supplied at all or short supplied or supplied late the purchaser shall be at liberty to procure the same from open market at the risk and expenses of the Supplier and the Supplier shall upon demand, pay to the purchaser all such extra charges and expenses as may be incurred or sustained in procuring and testing the same. The supplier will be solely responsible for any legal action under any statutory provisions of the law arising due to non-conforming quality of medicine/vaccine.
- (vii) Consignment of the drugs being supplied should pertain to the most recent manufacturing batch. The shelf life of the supplied medicines/drugs etc. at the time of delivery should not be less than $\frac{5}{6}$ of the labeled shelf life.

19. **Payment: -**

Payment will ordinarily be made within 45 days after the receipt of supply in good condition and pre-receipted bills in triplicate duly verified by I/C V.O., Central Store, Palam or Incharge District HQ. However, the payment will be released only after receipt of OK report of the samples, if sent to the Govt. approved laboratory for quality testing.

TDS (tax deducted at source) would be deducted from the amount payable to the contractor as per the applicable rules/instructions/orders of Government of India.

The payment to the tenderer will be made through Electronic Clearing System (ECS)/Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS), therefore, tenderer shall provide correct Name of Bank, Bank Address, Account holders name, Account No, IFSC code & MICR code of the bank.

20. Dispute and arbitration: -

ALL DISPUTES OR DIFFERENCES ARISING OUT OF OR IN RELATION TO THE CONTRACT SHALL BE RESOLVED BY THE MUTUAL DISCUSSION FAILING WHICH THE MATTER WILL BE REFERRED TO THE LT. GOVERNOR, GOVT. OF NCT OF DELHI OR HIS NOMINEE FOR SOLE ARBITRATION WHOSE DECISION SHALL BE FINAL AND BINDING ON THE CONTRACTING PARTIES.

21. Laws governing the contract: -

- a. This contract shall be governed by the laws of India
- b. Subject to para 15 hereinabove, the Courts of Delhi shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract.

22. Validity of Tender: -

TENDER VALIDITY PERIOD is for a period of Two year from the date of issue of rate contract

The firm and/or the purchaser are entitled to withdraw/cancel the Rate Contract by serving an appropriate notice on each other giving 15 (fifteen) days time. However, once a supply order is placed on the supplier for supply of a definite quantity in terms of the rate contract during the validity period of the rate contract, that supply order becomes a valid and binding contract.

HOWEVER, the Development Commissioner reserves the right to curtail or increase the validity of the contract, or cancel the tender as per rules.

23. Right to accept any bid and reject any or all bids: -

- a) The Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of NCT of Delhi is not bound to accept the lowest or any bid and may at any time by notice in writing to the bidders terminate the tendering process.

- 7. Delhi Government reserves the right to reject the tender of those companies whose past performance with Delhi Govt. was poor due to non-supply, delayed supply, erratic supplies and product failure.
- 8. Place of Delivery of Goods: For I/C Central Medicine Store, Veterinary Hospital Complex, Palam-New Delhi-110045 or District HQ or any other Vety. Hospital, if required (it will be indicated in supply orders)
- 9. The tenderers should be registered with Sales Tax Deptt/VAT (DST or CST).
